Reports of Standing committees, Officers and Trustees.

**John Thimmesch:** Someone needs to go ahead and get the container. Glu-lams?? We can buy bundles of wood to build our own for about \$450.00 dollars. We should be able to get one built and possibly two out of one bundle of wood. Jim brought up some different ideas as to what we could use to build better glu-lams that would last longer. Some discussion was had on this topic, and will look into some different materials.

**Steve Reinhart:** Gave a little more insight on the reason for spending the money to fix the glu-lams at the pistol range. Also checked into spotting scopes to use during sight in days and when the range is open for shooting. Checked at Harbor Freight and they didn't have any at the time but should be getting some soon.

**Phil Erickson:** Maybe we should look at getting some crushed rock to put down below where the container will sit. Also got some NRA applications from some different magazines and stores. Gave a list of all the members that have been approved in the year. The membership committee will go through the list and see who has had their orientation and cards made and who hasn't. A quick reminder, the woman's pistol class is May 6th. Someone is still driving on the hill behind the clubhouse. Phil and John think they know who it is and will keep an eye out and let him know that if this keeps up he will not be allowed to come back on club grounds.

**George Smith:** Got some bids on a new roof for the clubhouse and will bring these up for discussion at the next board meeting.

**Jim Locke:** Received some more paperwork on grants and will look it over and discuss them at the next board meeting. Finally talked to our NRA representative and is getting some applications mailed to the club. Need to see about getting some gravel to put on the road that goes all the way down to the 200yd range because the road has been getting torn up from trucks coming in and out bringing dirt in.

**New business:** Bill Davis and Jerry Papers with some guests from different organizations affiliated with IDPA gave a presentation to help further answer any questions to the general membership on the new range and action shooting. Things that were talked about are: why this is a good thing to have, who would use this, the kind of cost to the club to build such a facility, and the revenue it would bring in. This is something that is not only for the club, but law enforcement agencies have shown an interest in having a place like this to shoot at for their training. Jeff Phillips also presented his layout again to the board and members present as to what this should tentatively look like.

The kitty in the amount of \$12.00 dollars was won by Phil Erickson.

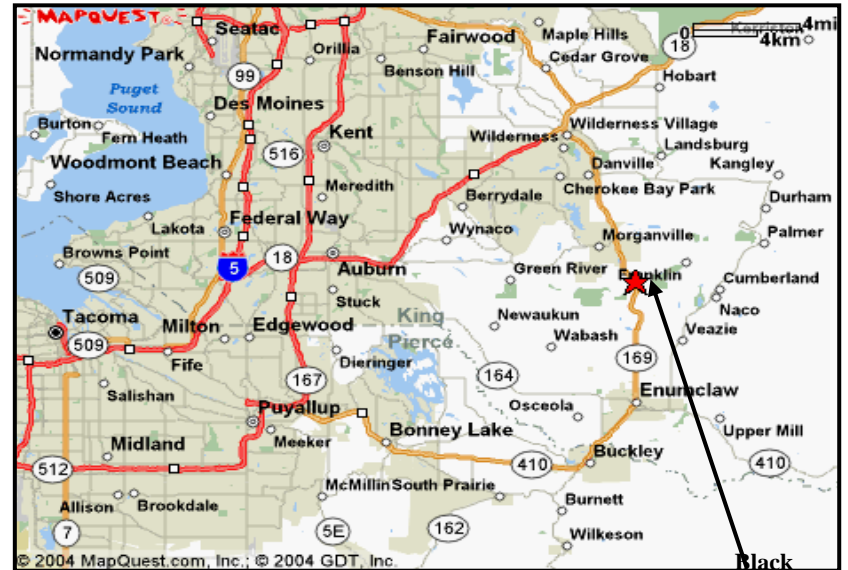
